**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-13**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 48 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF PALISADES PARK ENTITLED “OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES” TO REPEAL THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR.**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Palisades Park, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that Chapter 48: “Officers and Employees” of the Code of the Borough of Palisades Park is hereby amended as follows (~~stricken~~ text deleted; underlined text added):

**CHAPTER 48: OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES**

**ARTICLE XVI: MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR**

**§ 48-70. Residency.**

~~The Municipal Administrator shall be a resident of the Borough. If the Municipal Administrator is not a resident of Palisades Park at the time of appointment, the Municipal Administrator shall become a resident of Palisades Park within 90 days thereafter and will remain so during his/her tenure.~~


**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that, if any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that, if any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Ordinance and any prior ordinance of the Borough, the provisions hereof shall be determined to govern; and


**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that, if other parts, portions and provisions of the Code of the Borough of Palisades Park are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
